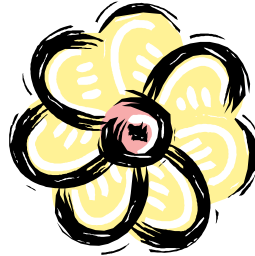

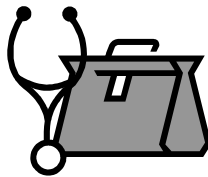
with St. Joseph's people attending in order to win. I am sure the committee is planning next year's trip already.
